

SGT. J. G. TOOTH.

The death has taken place from the effects of shell shock of Sgt. J. G. Tooth, son of the late Q.M.S. Tooth, of Luton and Shoebury-ness. He was aged 27 and had seen 13 years' continuous service, and was with the R.G.A. in France for 11 months. A widow is left. The body was brought to Luton and buried with military honours yesterday afternoon. Wreaths were sent by the widow, mother, three sisters, brother, and sister-in-law, Sgt. and Mrs. Sellwood, and Warrant Officers, Staff-Sergeant, and Sergeants, R.F.A., Luton.
